



Title of Bill: **Modification to Election Process**

Bill No **09.10**

Legislative Session: **05**

Introduction Date: **03/01/2010**

Sponsors: **UVHC President Na-Jee Harris.**

Summary of Purpose: **To modify the election process as outlined in the UVHC Constitution.**

1. WHEREAS, currently the Executive Board elections process is outlined in the constitution with Presidential candidates involved in the process as other Executive Board members, and
2. WHEREAS, having the Presidential elections within the same elections process as the other Executive Board members will result in having no presiding officer for the General Assembly meeting to coordinate the elections process effectively, and
3. WHEREAS, holding the Presidential elections during the General Assembly meeting prior to the General Assembly meeting in which the other Executive Board elections will be held does not conflict with the presiding officer conflict, now, therefore be it
4. ENACTED, that the Presidential Elections process shall be added to the UVHC Constitution,
5. FURHTERMORE, be it enacted, that the Presidential Elections process shall be read as follows:
 - a. UVHC Presidential Elections for the upcoming academic year shall take place at the 1st General Assembly meeting schedule during the month of April.
 - b. Presidential Election procedures shall take place as follows:
 - i. 5 minute presentation (PowerPoint, speech, etc);
 - ii. 3 minute Question and Answer session;
 - iii. 5 minute discussion (pros/cons) session.
 - c. All candidates shall:
 - i. Speak in an order determined by the Advisor;
 - ii. Shall submit to a question and answer session from the General Assembly;
 - iii. Shall remain out of the General Assembly during his/her discussion (pros/cons) session;
 - iv. Shall remain out of the General Assembly during the presentations, question and answer sessions, and discussion (pros/cons) sessions of all other candidates.
