5. Committee Reports

a. Finance, Budgeting, and Allocations

- Jones also reported Cookie 4 Coins will be held on Thursday, December 10th in lobby of each residence hall from 5-7 PM. Set up for this event will be at 4:30 PM.

b. Programming, Diversity, and Special Events



- Adduci reminded everyone that the Relaxation program will be held on Thursday, December 10th, from 7-9 in Phase I Room 300. Rodriguez, Boynes, Ober, Mosley said they would help with this event. Jones, Garcia, and Boyd will come up after Cookies 4 Coins to help out.

c. Housing and Campus Issues

- Harris reported that at his committee meeting, they were over all the items they had on their agenda to see what they have accomplished. The Peregrine Express issue was resolved, the cable issue is still pending, the internet issue is pending, but Gries has run speed tests and is planning to meet with CTIS soon.
- Also, the recycling and parking lot issues have been taken over by HRE staff.
- The committee further discussed campus lighting. Residents think there is not enough lighting on the walk back to the residence halls.
- There have also been issues with residents using the computer lab without having a key, and residents not cleaning out lint traps in the laundry rooms.

a. President

- Harris also reported that UVHC has accomplished more this semester than last year over two semesters and congratulated everyone for the effort they have put in to make this happen.

b. Vice President / NCC

c. Director of Finance

- Jones reported that the HRE budget is currently \$3331.56 and the general funds budget is \$203.04.

8. Advisor

- One of the responsibilities of this committee is going on safety walks with the Chancellor to find areas of improvement for campus safety. Ober and Hill have been on these walks and find them to be very beneficial.

- The date for the Hall Reps retreat is Saturday and Sunday, January 16th-17th. Hall Reps will have to report at 8 AM on Saturday. They will be doing some community service events, training, and fun events.

d. Survey for Hall Reps
